



POLITICAL PRISONERS' BIRTHDAYS IN DECEMBER

Cody Sutherlin and Alex Stuck are two of the Tinley Park 5. On Saturday May 19, 2012 five men were arrested in Tinley Park, a Chicago Suburb, for allegedly assaulting a number of white-supremacist organizers. One of the alleged "victims" was arrested on warrants for child pornography. Bond has been set at nearly \$1 Million dollars for the alleged attackers.

Tsutomu Shiroasaki is a Japanese national imprisoned in the United States. He has been accused of being a member of Japanese Red Army and participating in several attacks, including a mortar attack against a U.S. embassy. He is currently serving 30-years in a U.S Federal prison.

Zolo Azania is a former Black Panther convicted of a 1981 bank robbery that left a Gary, Indiana cop dead. He was arrested, unarmed, miles away from the incident. The prosecution intimidated witnesses, suppressed favorable evidence, presented false eyewitness and expert testimony, and denied him the right to speak or present motions in his own behalf.

Fred Burton is one of the Philly 5 a group of men accused of an alleged attack on a police station that left one officer killed. He was sentenced to a life term for murder. Burton has maintained his innocence since his arrest.

Connor Stevens is one of the Cleveland 4: four Occupy Cleveland activists who were arrested on May 1st, 2012, accused of plotting a series of bombings. However, the real story is that the FBI, working with an informant, created the scheme, produced the explosives, and coerced these four into participating. Connor was recently sentenced to 8 years 1 month.

Bradley Manning, a 23-year-old Army intelligence analyst, is accused of leaking a video showing the killing of civilians, including two Reuters journalists, by a US Apache helicopter crew in Iraq. He is also charged with sharing the documents known as the Afghan War Diary, the Iraq War Logs, and embarrassing US Diplomatic Cables, with the anti-secrecy website WikiLeaks.
